The Artisan brand is rapidly growing in the furniture industry and products are sold exclusively under the brand name, clearly indicating Bosnia and Herzegovina as the country of origin. Company currently employs 184 workers.

In order to improve product quality, environmental protection and health and safety at work, Artisan purchased a new wood processing machine Rover C 1648 CNC. The new machine is fully compliant with relevant EU Directives and improves the company's competitiveness in the international markets.

The high precision machine increases productivity, offers better environmental protection, reduces waste generation and improves the Occupational Health and Safety of workers.

The company received free technical assistance to optimize its investment project and 15% grant cash-back after the successful project verification, funded by the European Union.

With the investment, the company now meets a wide variety of standards, including:
